

Water Forum Round Table - May 7, 2002

There was a fair turnout at the Round Table this year. All of the special invitees were present with the exception of the Department of Agriculture. Other attendees were the United States Geological Survey, Army Corp of Engineers, Western association of Rural Water Users, and State Lands. Many of the reports were very similar to the updates given during the previous meeting.

With respect to Water Planning, the group suggested seeing the products generated during the Water Planning process. From that, individual groups and agencies can determine the significance of the products to their organization. Also, suggestions can be made to the Water Development Commission about products the future water plans could emphasize that would help an agency outside of WWDC. An example is the conservation districts need all water bodies mapped along with their classification.
