1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF DEVILS TOWER.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—The mountain at the Devils
5 Tower National Monument in Wyoming, located at 44 de-
6 grees, 42 minutes, 58 seconds north latitude, 104 degrees,
7 35 minutes, 32 seconds west longitude, shall continue to
8 be known and designated as "Devils Tower".

9 (b) **LEGAL REFERENCES.**—Any reference in any law,
10 map, regulation, document, paper, or other record of the
