7. THAT there are no intervening tributaries or other sources of water between the present point of diversion and the new point of diversion.

8. THAT your petitioner is the owner of the Blank Ditch; and a consent of Richard Roe, the owner of the Dot Ditch, to the change in point of diversion and means of conveyance, accompanies this petition.

9. THAT no appropriator from the same source of supply will be injured in any way.

10. THAT a map in duplicate, prepared by E. N. Johnson, a licensed professional engineer and land surveyor, of Laramie, Wyoming, and showing the location of both ditches so far as they affect this appropriation, accompanies this petition.

11. THAT recording fees in the amount of \$_____ accompany this petition.

IT IS THE PRAYER of the petitioner that he be allowed to change the point of diversion and means of conveyance of water from Blank Ditch, diverting from East Fork of North River, under Permit No. 21000, with priority of January 1, 1960, for the irrigation of:

Section 10, T.28N., R.70W.

10 acres - NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
20 acres - NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
30 acres - TOTAL

to the Dot Ditch, as identified in paragraph number 3 above, and diverting water from the same source of supply. That the same be allowed without loss of priority; that a proper notation be entered on both Permit Nos. 21000 and 18750; and that the petition be recorded in Miscellaneous Records in the State Engineer's Office.
